

State Center City Council
Special Meeting Minutes
June 28th 31, 2017

State Center City Council met in special session on Wednesday, June 28, 2017 in Council Chambers. Mayor Quick called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call: Mayor Quick, Councilors: Darrow, Lively, Riemenschneider and Wilkinson. Absent: Bunn. Also present: J. Robinson, K. Yates and Clerk Bearden. Robinson shared with the council that 2 interviews had been conducted for the new general labor position. The interview committee's recommendation is that this full-time permanent position be offered to Eric Hulbert with a starting wage of \$14.00/hr, a probation period of 6 months and a 50 cent wage increase with successful completion of that probation period. Lively motioned approval of Eric Hulbert under stated conditions. Darrow 2nd; motion passes 4-0. Darrow moved to approve year-end claims as presented. Riemenschneider 2nd; motion passes 4-0. Riemenschneider moved to approve an additional claim in amount of \$17.00 to the Marshall Co. Recorder to record the County issued special use permit for erection of the proposed solar array near the waste water treatment lagoon. Lively 2nd; motion passes 4-0. The clerk did not seek approval of any year-end transfers at this time. Robinson shared progress on the solar array design and 3rd St NW project. There was discussion regarding fireworks usage complaints being received. There being no further business, Councilor Wilkinson moved to adjourn at 7:22 p.m. Councilor Darrow 2nd; meeting adjourned, 4-0.
