

City Laborer

Job Description

The duties of a city laborer can range from filling potholes, trimming trees, picking up trash, cleaning bathrooms, setting utilities poles, running machinery, and filling in as needed per departments work load.

Working Environment

Some of the job duties of the laborer typically involve working outdoors, which means exposure to the elements. Because some of the work is physical involving such tasks as raking leaves, shoveling cold patch, back filling utility poles, and sweeping, a city laborer should be in good physical condition.

Minimum education, experience and certification

Valid Iowa Class B commercial driver's license with airbrakes endorsement with satisfactory driving record required within 30 days of hiring. Must maintain a valid CDL as a condition for continued employment. A pre-employment drug screen is required. Must be 18 years of age per Iowa Code 92.8.

Salary

The starting wage for the city laborer is \$12.00. If applicant has prior plumbing, welding experience, along with the ability to prepare concrete mix, install forms, and finish concrete the wage will be adjusted. After a 6 month probationary period a .50 cent raise will be added along with the possibility of more increases based on job performance. The City offers full Health Care Benefits along with IPERS.
