

Regarding: City of State Center Brush Pile

The Brush Pile was closed in 2020 by the Department of Natural Resources and cannot be reopened at the current location. Absolutely no dumping can be done at this site, either in the ditches or through the gate. There are cameras at the dump site, and anyone caught dumping will be fined.

The deposit amount for keys to the Brush Pile was \$20.00. If you had a check on file at City Hall, we've been in process of returning them to the address we have on file. If your deposit on file is in cash, you will be contacted and must pick the cash up from City Hall (we cannot send cash through the mail). You will be given an opportunity stop at City Hall for the cash, or apply it towards your utility account.

The City is continuing to research other possible locations for a dump site. If one cannot be located before spring, yard waste may be taken to the Marshalltown Compost Facility, which opens in early March.
